## Reading Readiness

1. Up Down  
Cut on dotted lines. Paste in correct column.
2. Hot Cold  
Cut on dotted lines. Paste in correct column.
3. Left Right  
Cut on dotted lines. Paste in correct column.
4. Trace your left hand. Trace your right hand.  
Learn this finger play: (Clap your knees with each hand in turn.)  
Left, right! Left, right!  
Left, right! Clap! (Clap hands together.)  
Left, right! Left, right!  
Left, right! Lap! (Place hands in lap.)
5. Left - Right Mittens  
Which mitten will fit the right hand?  
Which mitten will fit the left hand?  
  
Decorate the mittens. Use the same design for each mitten.  
Cut them out. Paste onto a sheet of large construction  
paper. Connect the mittens with a 12 inch piece of yarn.
6. First and Last  
Draw a line around each item that is first.  
Draw an X on each item that is last.
7. Sequence  
Cut out each set of pictures. Paste each set on a strip of  
construction paper.
